As the pandemic continues, AstraFemina will focus on virtual events in 2021 to continue our critical mission, returning to in-person events when safely feasible.



We successfully connected with young girls through our partnerships with Girl Scouts of the USA and Girlstart.



We supported 19 engagements, both virtually and in person, reaching over 10,000 girls across the country.
